

DHL introduces 35 Bio-LNG Trucks into British multinational retailer's fleet in the UK

DHL adds 35 new Volvo FM Liquefied Natural Gas (LNG) tractor units and replaces 35 diesel trucks



Customer Challenge

- Fleet of diesel trucks delivering goods for Customer



DHL Solution

- Introduction of 35 **new Bio-LNG** trucks fuelled with bio-LNG, replacing 35 diesel trucks
- Volvo G13C engine to deliver the same performance as its diesel-only counterpart with **max range of 1000 km**
- Trucks running in Peterborough, Swindon and Castle Donington, UK



Benefits and Impact

- Up to **80% reduction** in carbon emissions when fuelled with bio-LNG
- Expected reduction of **3,000 tones CO₂e** in carbon emissions each year
