DHL Thailand Flooding Situation Update

Dear Valued Customer,

Following our previous update regarding the flooding situation in Thailand, we would like to provide the latest operational status as of **28 September 2026**.

Air Freight

- Staff shortages at airport cargo terminals continue to impact cargo screening, tendering, and terminal acceptance.
- Truck availability remains constrained due to flooding, affecting pick-up and delivery services from some shipper locations.
- Thai Airways (TG) has implemented an embargo on both import and export cargo shipments until **2 October 2026** due to staffing constraints.

Ocean Freight

- **Laem Chabang Port, Lat Krabang ICD, and Bangkok River Port remain operational.**
- Rail transportation between Lat Krabang and Laem Chabang is temporarily suspended today and is expected to resume tomorrow.
- Truck transportation remains available, although transit times may be extended due to flooding and traffic congestion.
- No equipment shortages have been reported.

Customs Operations

The Thai government has announced public holidays for schools and civil service agencies on **28-29 September 2026**. Customs clearance activities may experience delays and require customs overtime support.

Current Impact

The primary impact remains on domestic transportation, particularly movements between **Lat Krabang and Laem Chabang**, while major ports and ICD facilities continue to operate normally. We are closely monitoring the situation and will provide further updates should conditions change significantly.
