




CONTAINERSHIP SIZE: THE PANAMAX SIMPLIFYING OCEAN LOGISTICS



Panamax and **Neo-Panamax** ships can be routed through the Panama Canal in Central America, as they are as wide as the Canal allows. Panamax ships carry up to **5,000 TEUs**; Neo-Panamax, introduced after the canal's expansion, **14,000**.



Post-Panamax ships are even wider and must bypass the Canal. They and other **Ultra-Large Container Vessels (ULCV)** carry the largest cargo amount, some well in excess of **20,000 TEUs**.
