Remarks

- Station to station transit times reliable and short: 14 days to Poland, and 18-20 days to Germany
- Rail freight costs generally stable
- Train capacity tight in Xi'an port in the first half of January
- ETD delay in Chengdu hub due to backlog from November 2022

Remarks

- Eastbound train capacity available
- Short booking to ETD time: departure within 7-12 days from the booking
- Rates stable
- Chinese New Year (starts 22nd January) holiday period will impact delivery & operations in China





Railway track width & main hubs across the route:

MARKET UPDATES



15,162 China-Europe block trains, Westbound & Eastbound, have been arranged from January to November 2022, according to China Railway.

Comparing with 2021, total number of trains in eleven months of 2022 grew by 10%. Container volume grew by 11% and reached 1.475 million TEU.



Uzbekistan has dispatched first freight train to Europe – informed Uzbekistan Railways on 19th January 2023.

Train loaded with ninety one 20' containers uses Middle Corridor to deliver copper to Turkey, from where it is distributed to European importers. Route bypasses Russia, and leads from Uzbekistan through Turkmenistan, Caspian Sea, Azerbaijan, Georgia, Black Sea to Bulgaria, where cargo is reloaded in the Varna port onto the train to Turkey.
