




# DHL Global Trade Barometer expects moderate acceleration of trade growth in Great Britain, mainly driven by just two sectors

# Key findings:

- The positive trade outlook for Great Britain is accelerating, with an index value of 63, up +2 points compared to December
- Slight decrease in GTB outlook for British air trade, which is mainly driven by basic raw materials and machinery parts
- Increase by +6 points marks significant improvement of prospects for British ocean trade, which is largely driven by industrial raw materials and land vehicles & parts

Generally, trade in Great Britain is expected to increase moderately. The current trade dynamics in Great Britain are clearly driven by a strong performance in ocean trade. The GTB attributes this to a range of growth drivers, led by trade in basic raw materials, followed by machinery parts & components and industrial raw materials, ranking second and third place respectively. A number of other sectors makes a positive contribution as well.

Air trade growth is expected to remain positive (64), although the index dropped -2 points compared to December. Imports of consumer goods and high technology is expected to drive growth in the upcoming period. In addition, air imports and exports of basic raw materials and machinery parts are expected to positively contribute to the growth of British air trade as well.

The British ocean trade growth is expected to accelerate (62) with the index rising significantly by +6 points compared to December. Exports of industrial raw materials together with ocean imports and exports of automotive commodities are expected to drive British ocean trade growth.

The DHL Global Trade Barometer an early indicator for the current state and future development of global trade. It is based on import and export data for a number of intermediates and early-cycle commodities that serve as the basis for further industrial production. Sources for the index are aggregated market data from air and containerized ocean freight from seven countries (China, South Korea, Germany, India, Japan, UK, USA), which account for more than 75 percent of world trade. These data are evaluated using artificial intelligence and various statistical methods and compressed to a single index value that represents the weighted average of the current growth and the upcoming two months of trade. The index, which was designed in cooperation with Accenture, is published four times a year by DHL on a global scale as well as for each of the seven countries surveyed.
