1. What qualifies as a heavy weight shipment?

A heavy weight shipment typically refers to goods weighing over 50 kg. These shipments are often palletized, bulky, or high-value, and may require specialised handling, documentation, and coordination – especially when shipping internationally.

2. What is the difference between DHL Heavy Weight Express and standard air freight?

The main difference lies in speed, control, and visibility.

Standard air freight usually involves multiple providers – such as freight forwarders, airlines, and local carriers – which can lead to fragmented tracking and variable transit times.

DHL Heavy Weight Express, by contrast, operates through a fully integrated, end-to-end network, offering faster, time-definite delivery, consistent tracking, and a single point of accountability from pickup to delivery.

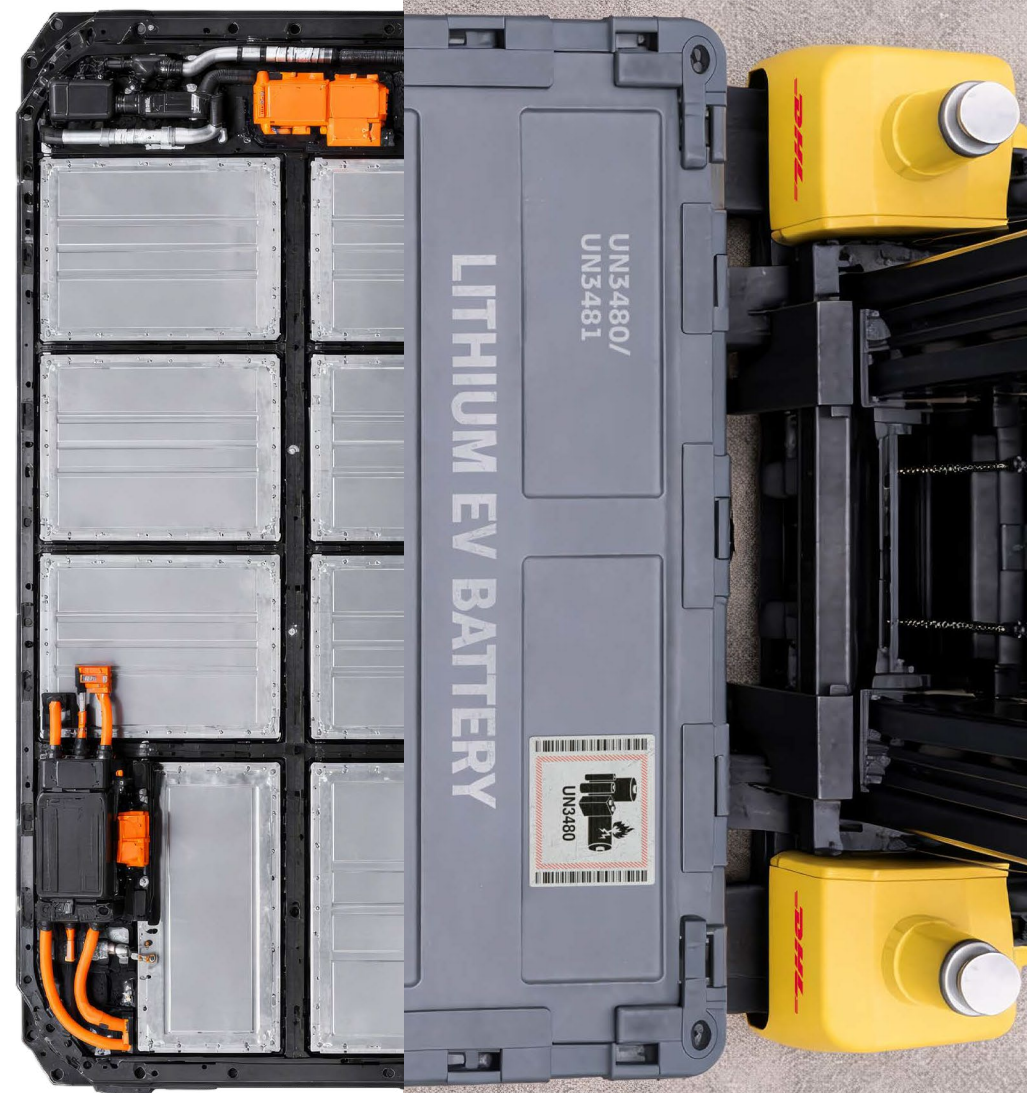
